Famed Blind Singer Andrea Bocelli Almost Aborted

You may have heard the story of the medical school professor who poses the scenario of a pregnant woman who has TB, the father is syphilitic, several of their offspring are blind or deaf....The professor asks the class, "What would you do?" One of the students responds, "Abort the fetus," to which the professor responds, "You just killed Beethoven." Below is a modern-day equivalent of that situation.

ROME, June 4, 2010 What would the world have been like without Andrea Bocelli, Italian pop, opera, and classical singer? With millions of infants having been victim to abortion, the blind international music sensation has revealed that he too could have been one more abortion statistic.

The "I am Whole Life" project has produced a YouTube video with Bocelli, playing the piano, recounting the story of a young woman who had been hospitalized and treated for a "simple attack of appendicitis."

As Bocelli recounts, doctors had suggested to his mother that she "abort the child" because the child would be born with a disability.

"But the young brave wife decided not to abort, and the child was born," recounted Bocelli. "That woman was my mother, and I was the child."

Bocelli was born in 1958 to Alessandro and Edi Bocelli. At his birth, doctors diagnosed him as having congenital glaucoma, and by age 12 he was completely blind.

"Maybe I am partisan, but I can say it was the right choice," said Bocelli.

Millions of Bocelli's fans worldwide could also agree.

In spite of this disability, Bocelli developed a passion for music that would lead to a career of international hit singles, eight operas, and 70 million copies of his albums.

For years Bocelli used to be an agnostic, but returned to his Christian Catholic faith in 1994, in part due to reading the works of Leo Tolstoy, which are said to have convinced him that life was not random chance, but had a purpose.

Bocelli said he hoped that the story of his brave mother "could encourage many mothers that find themselves in difficult situations in those moments when life is complicated, but want to save the life of their baby."

"The Pill Kills" Day

On Tuesday June 8, a dedicated team of Napa pro-lifers commemorated the anniversary of the Supreme Court decision in Griswold vs. Connecticut, the decision to permit distribution of the deadly concoctions sold as birth control medications. The Napers joined the nationwide American Life League-sponsored "The Pill Kills" day at Planned Parenthood locations, abortion mills, pharmacies and other places where the birth control pill is readily available.

The attention-demanding sign created by American Life League proclaimed the theme: "THE PILL KILLS," as the praying continued for the designated hour of "Pill Kills Day" outside the Planned Parenthood clinic in Napa. Napa clients insist Napa doesn't do abortions; they only give pills, shots, patches and IUDs.



"The Pill Kills" day began in Napa at 9:30 AM on Tuesday, June 8th, in front of the Napa, California Planned Parenthood office [PP]. For one hour prayers were offered for the many uninformed/misinformed patrons who come asking the staff of Planned Parenthood to provide chemicals, hormones, and sex-education as an answer to their ignorance concerning the natural consequences of abuse of sex.

Prayers included the needs of our sidewalk counselors advising patrons about the terrible dangers inherent in the concoctions of chemicals and the mechanical abortifacient devices sold inside. Counselors offered informative pamphlets detailing the devastating effects of the pill, the shot, and the IUD. Facts and research results showed natural, healthy reproductive capability is chemically or mechanically made unfit and the body is subjected to greatly increased risk of long-term, dangerous side-effects. Patrons were informed about the dreaded "breakthrough." Even though motherhood isn't "planned," and the women may not even know fertilization has occurred, the pills and Inter Uterine Devices (IUD's) make them mothers of dead babies who wait to greet them when they "pass on." The chemicals and IUD's starve and kill these precious pre-born babes in the secret warmth of inhospitable,

In reality, though, in the USA, in addition to the 3,000+ surgical abortions every day, there are between 21,000 and 30,000 babies who die of hunger in sterile wombs every day in America - 7 to 10 times the number of surgical abortions, using chemicals and mechanical devices to starve the innocent victims of abortion through the distribution of birth control concoctions and mechanical devices.

In Italy – a Woman in a coma Give Birth to Baby Girl

At the Riuniti hospital in Bergamo, Italy, a 40-year-old woman said to be in a vegetative state for the past four months following a brain hemorrhage in January, gave birth to a baby girl. The baby, named Gaia, was born by caesarean at 34 weeks. She weighs 2 kilos and is in good health.

In January 2010, the husband and doctors decided not to have the baby born prematurely but to wait till the term of the pregnancy. The doctors monitored the mother and the fetus. The fetus developed normally until birth.

Man Appears Free of HIV After Rare Full Transplant Involving Adult Stem Cells

Berlin, Germany (LifeNews.com) -- A 42-year-old HIV patient with leukemia appears to have no detectable HIV in his blood and no symptoms after a stem cell transplant from a donor carrying a gene mutation that confers natural resistance to the virus that causes AIDS, according to a report published last week in the *New England Journal of Medicine*.

"The patient is fine," said Dr. Gero Hutter of Charite Universitätsmedizin Berlin in Germany. "Today, two years after his transplantation, he is still without any signs of HIV disease and without antiretroviral medication."

The case was first reported in November, and the new report is the first official publication of the case in a medical journal. Hutter and a team of medical professionals performed the stem cell transplant on the patient, an American living in Germany, to treat the man's leukemia, not the HIV itself.

However, the team deliberately chose a compatible donor who has a naturally occurring gene mutation that confers resistance to HIV. The mutation cripples a receptor known as CCR5, which is normally found on the surface of T cells, the type of immune system cells attacked by HIV.

In addition to performing for millions of people, Eric has composed and recorded CDs and written music for film, documentaries, television and Internet media. His concerts are a definite must-see and have proven riveting for all music lovers.
